Guided by the African proverb, "*If you want to go fast, go alone; If you want to go far, go together,*" members of the Better Together Brain Trust (or BT2) met at BECMA's first EV Kickstarter in 2021.

- Headquartered in Nubian Square
- Since joining forces, BT2 has gained Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) certification from the Commonwealth, as well as Small Local Business Enterprise (SLBE) and MBE certification from the City of Boston.
- They were recently awarded two contracts, including a project for EV charging stations with the City of Boston.
