**A BILL**

To amend title 49, United States Code, to ensure that revenues collected from passengers as aviation security fees are used to help finance the costs of aviation security screening by repealing a requirement that a portion of such fees be credited as offsetting receipts and deposited in the general fund of the Treasury.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Funding for Aviation  
5 Screeners and Threat Elimination Restoration Act” or the  
6 “FASTER Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF REQUIREMENT REGARDING CREDITING**  
2 **AND DEPOSIT OF A PORTION OF AVIATION**  
3 **SECURITY FEES.**

4 (a) REPEAL.—Section 44940 of title 49, United  
5 States Code, is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (c), by striking paragraph (3);

7 (2) in subsection (f)—

8 (A) by striking the heading and inserting

9 “DEPOSIT AND AVAILABILITY OF FEE.—”;

10 (B) by striking paragraph (1);

11 (C) by redesignating paragraphs (2) and

12 (3) as paragraphs (1) and (2), respectively; and

13 (D) by amending paragraph (1), as so re-  
14 designated, to read as follows:

15 “(1) shall be deposited into a separate account  
16 in the Treasury, which shall be available to the Ad-  
17 ministrator for expenditure only to pay the costs of  
18 activities and services for which the fee is imposed;  
19 and”; and

20 (3) by striking subsection (i).

21 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Subsection (d)(4)  
22 of such section is amended by striking “, other than sub-  
23 section (i),”.
