A BILL

To provide for the carriage of certain television broadcast stations, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. CARRIAGE OF TELEVISION BROADCAST STA-4 TIONS.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi6 sion of law, a cable operator may transmit to subscribers
7 in any county in the designated market area of Albany,
8 New York, any television broadcast station that—

(1) was retransmitted to subscribers located in
 that designated market area on December 1, 2016;
 and

4 (2) as of the date of enactment of this Act, is
5 not retransmitted to all subscribers in that des6 ignated market area.

7 (b) NEGOTIATIONS.—A cable operator that engages 8 in the retransmission described in subsection (a) shall en-9 gage in good faith negotiations within the meaning of sec-10 tion 76.65 of title 47, Code of Federal Regulations, or any 11 successor thereto, with a television broadcast station re-12 garding the terms of such retransmission.

13 (c) RULES OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this Act14 shall be construed—

(1) to alter any nonduplication or syndicated
exclusivity rights of an in-market station network
that are prescribed by contract or provided under
section 325 of the Communications Act of 1934 (47)
U.S.C. 325); or

20 (2) to affect the applicability of any other com21 munications or copyright law related to the retrans22 mission of a television broadcast station by a cable
23 operator.
