Dear President Biden:

America's Arctic is a place like none other in our nation. Providing meaningful and enduring protections to these iconic public lands will ensure these irreplaceable landscapes remain critical carbon sinks, premiere tourist destinations, unparalleled wildlife habitat, and a place where Indigenous traditions can continue for generations to come. It is for these reasons that we are encouraged and supportive of your announcement on September 6, 2023 to further protect key areas of America's Arctic, one of our planet's last remaining intact ecosystems.

On the first day of your Administration, you rightfully directed a review of the oil and gas leasing program for the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge (Refuge) which was rushed through in the waning days of the Trump Administration. The Interior Department's review found numerous legal errors with that leasing program and directed a new analysis. We support your strengthened environmental review of the congressionally mandated oil and gas leasing program in the Refuge, including the release of the draft supplemental environmental impact statement (SEIS) and canceling the unlawful Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority leases. As outlined in your recent announcement, oil and gas development on the fragile Coastal Plain would threaten sensitive species and the Gwich'in people's way of life. In the final SEIS and decision, we urge you to include considerations of the climate and ecological impacts from leasing in the Refuge and adopt the strongest possible protections for these exceptional public lands.

We also greatly appreciate your efforts to expand protections for more than 13 million acres of land in the National Petroleum Reserve-Alaska (Reserve) in the Western Arctic, an area of critical environmental, climate, and cultural importance. However, the recent approval of the Willow Project highlights the critical need to safeguard the 2.5 million acres of sensitive habitat under existing leases, as well as the millions of additional acres still open to future leasing in the Reserve. As soon as this fall, your Administration will face key decisions on oil projects in the Reserve that could be 3 to 5 times bigger than Willow. In order to meet our nation's stated climate and conservation goals, it is critical that your Administration considers additional protective measures and takes proactive action to safeguard the Reserve from any planned developments, such as a westward expansion of Willow and the Peregrine Oil Project.

Mr. President, the rapidly warming Arctic is not only a harbinger of the looming climate crisis, its preservation is an essential element of our nation's climate and conservation goals. For there to be any hope of meeting Paris climate goals, the supply of fossil fuels must be curtailed—the International Energy Agency has said there should be no new investment in fossil fuel supply projects if the world is to successfully reach net-zero emissions by 2050.

Thank you and we look forward to working with you to permanently protect these magnificent landscapes for the enduring benefits they provide people and the planet.
